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UK Modern Slavery Act Transparency Statement

This statement is made pursuant to Section 54, Part 6 of the United Kingdom Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the "Act") and sets out the steps that Sift Science, Inc. ("Sift"), and affiliated group companies, has taken to ensure that slavery and human trafficking are not taking place within its business or supply chain. The Act was created to define the opposition to modern slavery and trafficking in the United Kingdom, and requires businesses subject to the Act to publish an annual statement.
