

# FY 2025 Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement

## **ABOUT THIS STATEMENT**

Nippon LP Resources UK Limited (“NLPR UK”) is managing investment in a copper mine in Chile. NLPR UK is incorporated in England and Wales (Company number 11135506).

The Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the “Act”) requires certain businesses to provide disclosure concerning their efforts to address the issues of Slavery and Human Trafficking in their supply chain.

As a company doing business in the UK, NLPR UK has produced FY2025 Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement (the “Statement”) in response to requirements of Section 54 of the Act.

The statement is intended to communicate the steps that NLPR UK has taken during the previous fiscal year of 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025 to ensure that slavery and human trafficking are not occurring in any part of its supply chains.

We have zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking. To ensure all those in our supply chain and contractors comply with our values we have in place a supply chain compliance programme.

## **TRAINING**

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains and our business, we provide training to our staff. 
## **OUR EFFECTIVENESS IN COMBATING SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING**
