Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement for the financial year to 31 March 2024

Company Overview

Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC is a special purpose company responsible, in accordance with the terms of a PFI Contract, for the refurbishment and ongoing delivery of services for Peterborough City Hospital, Peterborough Cavell Centre and Peterborough City Care Centre for a term of 35 years. It is a wholly owned subsidiary of the holding company, Peterborough (Progress Health) Holdings Limited. Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC has 3 clients, The North West Anglia NHS Foundation Trust, The Cambridgeshire and Peterborough NHS Foundation Trust and NHS Property Services Limited.

Supply Chain

Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC has no direct employees. Long term contracts are in place with key suppliers for the provision of management services and the delivery of facilities management and building management services. These supply contracts are with parties approved by the 3 clients and hold any required accreditations or appropriate qualifications for the services that they deliver. All the services provided are to all 3 sites site and are UK based. Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC considers these key suppliers to be in locations and areas of activity that are low risk in relation to slavery and human trafficking.

Policy

The board of directors of Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC has zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking and has confirmed a commitment to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in the company or the supply chain.

Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC expects all those in the supply chain to adhere to a policy of zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking.

Due Diligence Processes

As part of an ongoing due diligence process to identify and mitigate the risk of slavery and human trafficking in the supply chain, Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC provides its anti-slavery and human trafficking statement and policy to its largest and key supplier organisations and has requested their acknowledgement and commitment to comply with this policy as a supplier to Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC. Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC has also made enquiries to these key supplier organisations using a questionnaire to ascertain if they have a policy within their organisation; requesting a copy and an outline of how this is monitored together with a summary of steps taken or proposed to monitor this within their respective supply chains.

Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC intends to provide this statement for the financial year to 31 March 2024 to its key suppliers and to monitor their policies.

Peterborough (Progress Health) PLC will review this statement on an annual basis.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending 31 March 2024.
