ORGANISATION'S STRUCTURE

We are a property investment and development company. We own and develop properties mainly in London. We are a subsidiary of Mitsubishi Estate Europe Limited, which is our regional headquarters in Europe. We are a part of Mitsubishi Estate Group (Group), and our ultimate parent company is Mitsubishi Estate Company Limited in Japan. The Group has over 10,000 employees worldwide and operates in Europe, North America and Asia. The Group has a global annual turnover of over £7,000,000,000.

OUR BUSINESS

Our business in Europe is organised into more than 10 business units: all of them have been established for the purpose of owning properties.

OUR SUPPLY CHAINS

We have no supply chains in our business.

OUR POLICIES ON SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING

We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business. We have zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking. To ensure all those in our supply chain and contractors comply with our values we have in place a supply chain compliance programme.

TRAINING

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains and our business, we provide training to our staff.

OUR EFFECTIVENESS IN COMBATING SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING

We have appointed the compliance manager to conduct a review to bring insights on ways to we can tackle slavery and human trafficking. The compliance manager uses appropriate measures to assess how effective we have been in ensuring that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place in any part of our business or supply chains.
