

Modern Slavery Statement

CW Duke are familiar with the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and are aware that Section 54 requires certain organisations to develop a slavery and human trafficking statement each year.

The Act stipulates that:

Every organisation carrying on a business in the UK with a total annual turnover of £36m or more will be required to produce a slavery and human trafficking statement for each financial year of the organisation.

CW Duke's Annual Turnover is circa £9m so they are not classified as a relevant commercial organisation as defined by the above and not required to produce a slavery and human trafficking statement for each financial year of the organisation.

The policy was approved on **2nd January 2025** following consultation with senior managers, workers, workers' representatives, and trade unions.

Overall responsibility for the effectiveness of the policy lies with Mr Steve Cameron.
