In our business, we do not employ any forced labour.

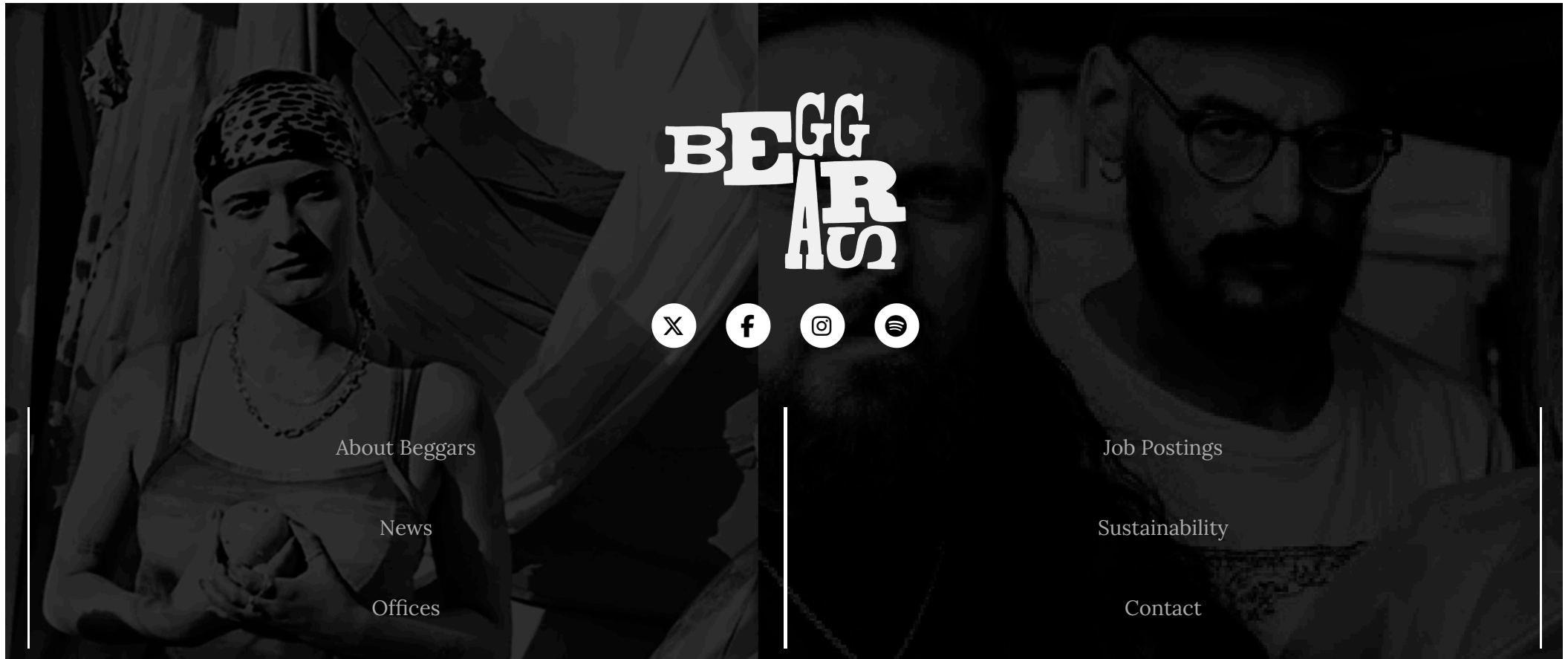
