They are encouraged to report any incident of ethical concern that they witness, including forced labour, child labour, human trafficking or any other human rights abuses.

While no country or industry can be immune from the risks of modern slavery, it is everyone's responsibility to take steps to guard against such risks, and we at Coach House support safe and voluntary employment within our suppliers and supply chain.
