Don & Low Ltd prohibits workplace harassment as per the harassment policy found in the employee handbook, and we respect workers' freedom to associate, by way of a trade agreement, which assures we respect the ability of employees to choose whether or not to join unions and engage in collective bargaining. Don & Low Ltd has implemented a health and safety policy to ensure not only our employees' safety but the safety of the surrounding communities in which we operate.

DUE DILIGENCE PROCESSES FOR SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING

As part of our initiative to identify and mitigate risk we have in place systems to:

- identify and assess potential risk areas when considering taking on new suppliers and regularly review our existing supply chain,
- review the potential for risk at regular intervals, including the possibility of re-auditing a supplier or conducting spot checks, and
- protection for whistle blowers.
